

Texas FBLA Board of Directors

The Board of Directors of Texas Future Business Leaders of America in cooperation with Texas Education Agency staff is to establish policy and long-range plans for the organization. The Board consists of one elected adviser from each Area, and two business representatives. The State Chairman, State Adviser, State Officer Coordinator, current student State President, and the Middle Level Representative shall be ex-officio, non-voting members of the Board.

The Board shall meet twice a year, usually at the Professional Development Conference each summer and at the Mid-Year Planning Meeting. Additional meetings may be called as necessary.

This is not an intense, time-consuming position as Board members are to set policy, not administer the organization. However, most Board members are active in the organization and see their position as a unique learning experience!

FBLA Board members are elected for no more than four two-year consecutive terms. Odd numbered Areas elect Board members in odd-numbered **SLC** years; even numbered Areas elect Board members in even **SLC** years.

Elections will be held within each Area at the State Leadership Conference during the Friday Area Meeting. Advisers only will vote. Each chapter may cast one vote for a Board member. Election is by a simple majority.

Persons interested in serving on the Board of Directors are required to submit an application and resume to the State Adviser by the SLC registration deadline.

Qualifications:

- Must be a member of **Area 1, 3, 5, 7**
- Must have the desire and commitment to seek the best for the organization and its members
- Must have at least three years experience as an FBLA adviser
- Must be willing to devote time to devote to the organization
- Willingness to attend and participate in all called Board Meetings
- Access to email as most communications are conducted via email

All interested candidates for Areas 1, 3, 5, and 7 positions should complete the Board of Director's application and **send it, along with a resume** to Betty Scott, State Adviser, 200 Briarwood Lane, Aledo, TX 76008 by **March 9**.
